

**NSF – GMP- NSF** – Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) registration is the assurance that our product has the identity, strength, composition, quality and purity that appear on our label. This means all our claims on the products are genuine and authentic. This GMP requirement is the only American National Standard in the dietary supplement industry developed in accordance with the FDA’s 21 CFR part 111.

**BRC Certification**– British Retail Consortium (BRC) is a trade association for the UK food retail industry. The BRC has published standards for the best practices for the food and manufacturing industries. The standard is designed as a “total quality management” program and includes both food safety requirements and quality requirements which food manufacturers must meet in order to be certified.

**ISO22000:2005**-This certificate ensures that products comply to food safety management system and they are safe for the consumer according to the intended use. Also, certifies that we have the ability to control food safety hazards in order to ensure that food is safe at the time of human consumption. We are certified by URS India.

**FSSAI**– Certified by Food Safety and Standards Authority of India. This is the standard laid down by Government of India for the articles of food and to regulate their manufacture, storage, distribution, sale and import to ensure availability of safe and wholesome food for human consumption.
